

Safari by jeep

Aboard your jeep, an expert guide/game spotter will take you on an in-depth tour of Kenya's biodiverse ecosystems, home to 25,000 different animal species. 3 ways to observe Kenya's wildlife


There are several adventurous ways to explore Kenya's wildlife-rich landscapes. Pursue lions across the vast savannah in a jeep. Get a bird's eye view of migrating herds from a hot air balloon. Hop in a boat and cruise past hippos on the shores of Lake Naivasha. From any of these vantage points, you'll gain a perspective of Kenya that will impact you forever.

Safari by boat

Set off across serene Lake Naivasha, admiring the natural beauty and diverse wildlife that surrounds you. Spot a wide variety of birds flying high in the sky above. Observe giant hippos basking in the shallow waters, as well as Cape buffalo and antelope wading in the swamps. Gaze upon giraffes towering over the trees inhabited by Colobus monkeys. Your guide doubles as your driver and game spotter, making sure you and your fellow travelers enjoy every minute of your incredible small boat safari.

Safari by hot air balloon

Soar silently over the Masai Mara National Reserve's most inaccessible parts in a hot air balloon. From high above, enjoy panoramic vistas in the early morning light and observe the herds of wildlife as they migrate towards food and water. As you climb higher into the atmosphere, use your ears to appreciate the vibrant microcosm of life beneath you. Even from this height, you'll still be able to hear the deep roar of lions, the screech of mischievous baboons, the cheerful trumpet of elephants and the thunder of wildebeest rumbling across the grasslands. As you descend, you won't want to come down from the high of one unforgettable experience.

The Organopónico and other co-op gardens around the island facilitate development within the community and provide easy access to the fresh ingredients needed to cook delicious and healthy meals for their own families.

Flowering Medellín

This level of determination is reflected in the city's industry and public-works projects, and it's no wonder Medellín has grown to be the second largest city in Colombia.
